Tonight I want us to look at whether or not Jesus **walked the walk** that he thought and talked.

**Did Jesus act like God?**

1. Matthew 16.21, Luke 6.8, Luke 11.17-Jesus **knew all things**.
2. Matthew 28.8, John 11.38 and his miracles in general-Jesus is **all powerful**.
3. Matthew 18.20, 28.20-Jesus is **everywhere**.
4. John 8.25, John 17.5, and John 1-Jesus as **always existed**.

These five are great ways to know that Jesus was God but I believe the **best** example is found in **Mark 2.1-12**.

Here the act that Jesus did that was reserved for God alone was **forgiving of sins**.

**So What do we do with this?**

**Realize** that who Christ said he was, he **actually** was.

- He really did walk the walk that he was talking.

Allow God to **forgive** you of past mistakes.

Claim the promise of **Isaiah 43.25**.

You don't have to live in **fear** of your past mistakes.

Tonight can be the night you break free from **guilt, hopelessness, and despair**.
