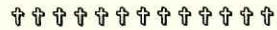

MISSIONARIES DRs. ANITA AND RICK GUTIERREZ TO VISIT

Why didn't the chicken cross the road? Find out when Drs. Anita and Rick Gutierrez, our American Baptist missionaries in South Africa visit with us on Sunday, April 22nd. They will worship with us during the 9:30 service, be introduced at the beginning of the 11:00 service, and then share about their work in detail in Dennis Dudley's class at 11:15 in Room 200. All are welcome to attend!

Providing chickens, a dome to house them in and incubators are part of their ministry. They also teach gardening skills and nutrition. They train and equip local churches, pastors and missionaries to combat life-style related diseases like HIV/AIDS, heart and artery disease, diabetes and malaria. Portable rapid screening tests for these conditions are offered by trained health builders.

The doctors are developing a health education DVD series that can be studied individually or in small groups. A holistic approach from the Christian perspective is offered in order to help people achieve their health and life goals. The vision is to train two or four health builders in each participating church. These health builders teach their neighbors about chickens and gardens and nutrition and health! They would like to see this model of health building become a part of local church missions throughout Africa and other resource-limited settings.

We are providing graduation caps and gowns to be used in the health builder graduation ceremonies. Some of their health care worker graduates did not participate in the ceremonies because they didn't have a cap and gown. We now have collected 11 gowns and 5 caps. Please hang them in the coat room opposite the library.
